

Multisensory Classroom Tools Checklist

- Sand trays, rice bins, or salt-writing trays for letter/word tracing
- Textured alphabet cards or tactile letter tiles
- Lively Letters or other sound-symbol multisensory programs
- Elkonin boxes with colored chips or beads
- Magnetic letters, letter tiles, or moveable alphabet pieces
- Rhyming and CVC word family manipulatives
- Syllable tapping cards or beat markers
- Movement-based cards for verbs, prepositions, and action sequencing
- Props for story retells (puppets, figurines, themed objects)
- Adapted books with Velcro pieces and interactive elements
- Graphic organizers with tactile icons (felt pieces, laminated visuals)
- Vocabulary bins filled with objects for hands-on exploration
- Boom Cards or interactive digital lessons with audio-visual cues
- Sensory pathways or classroom movement stations
- Fidgets or sensory tools for regulation during learning tasks
